

#### 1.4 Bachelor of Ministry (B. Min)

The Bachelor of Ministry degree is a 4-year programme for students who desire to pursue a more practical training programme of 1 year of studies beyond the Diploma in Theology. This programme provides the student with the opportunity to develop his / her ministry skills in practical theology and at the same time continue to be involved in a ministry that utilises the student's gifts. In addition to the requirements of the Diploma in Theology, the candidate must complete another 30 Units which will comprise of the following:
