

1.2 Diploma in Theology (Dip. Th.)

By completing a further year in addition to the Certificate in Theology programme, students may graduate with the Diploma in Theology. The Diploma in Theology is a 3-year programme (another year after the Certificate in Theology) that takes the student beyond the Certificate in Theology. The Diploma consists of an additional 30 Units (i.e. 27 Units of academic work and 3 Units for Practicum). Electives (6 Units) allow the student to develop his/her own areas of interest and calling. The composition of the programme is as follows:
