

GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

First degree holders (or equivalent) from Bible colleges, seminaries, colleges and universities are eligible for these graduate programmes. Transfer of credits from other institutions may be considered on a case-by-case basis, but should not exceed more than 50% of the required credit hours to fulfill course requirements at MBS. The Graduate Programmes offer the following diploma or degrees as listed below.

2.1 **Graduate Diploma in Christian Studies** (Grad. Dip. C. S) (30 Units)

This is a 1-year full-time programme which forms the foundational graduate programme for the Master of Christian Studies (MCS) degree. It is designed to provide the student with a basic understanding of the Christian faith. Emphasis is placed on Biblical and Theological Studies at the graduate level. This programme is also offered on a modular basis, regulated at between 3 and 4 modules per year. Students can also register on a part-time basis.
